27TH ANNUAL SHARK TOURNAMENT:

With over \$300,000 paid out last year in cash, custom trophies and other prizes, this is one tournament the avid sportfisherman does not want to miss.

Mario Cervone aboard Capt. Jason Blake's "Blue Eyes" landed a 346-lb. Thresher, earning the crew top honors for the Heaviest Shark of the Tournament, the Heaviest Shark of Day 2, Heaviest Fish (Other) and the Heaviest Shark in its category. These awards earned the crew just shy of \$40,000 in cash prizes.

The Heaviest Blue Shark was caught by Jenner Smith, aboard Capt. Eric Stegich's "Miss O," weighing in at 251 lbs. Sean Kinny aboard Capt. Chuck Mallinson's "Joy Sea" hauled in a 311-lb. Mako, earning \$5,000 for Heaviest Mako.

Over the course of these two days, 92 boats and 600 anglers brought in 20 fish, including five Makos, two Threshers and 13 Blue Sharks.

So mark your calendars; the Captain's Meeting for the 28th Annual Star Island Shark Tournament will be held on Thursday night, June 12th, with tournament fishing Friday, June 13th and Saturday, June 14th. The awards ceremony and dinner will follow fishing on Saturday night, accompanied by live music and dancing under the stars.

There are 12 Tournament prizes, including \$30,000 for the Heaviest Qualifying Shark of the Tournament; \$5,000 each Day for the Heaviest Qualifying Shark of the day; \$5,000 for the Heaviest Qualifying Mako; \$3,500 for the Heaviest Qualifying "Other" category Shark which includes Thresher, Hammerhead, and Tiger Shark; and \$2,500 for the Heaviest Qualifying Blue Shark of the tournament. In addition there are seven Calcuttas ranging from \$200 to \$20,000 each.

For those anglers who wish to get in on the action but do not own a boat, Star Island Yacht Club is home to Montauk's finest and most accomplished Charter Captains. These boats can accommodate up to six anglers and can be chartered for ONE or BOTH days of the tournament.

In addition to this outstanding competition, all anglers can contribute to the study of the shark by tagging and releasing sharks that do not meet strict weight requirements. Last year, over 250 sharks were released back to the ocean. Of the sharks that were weighed in, over 650 lbs. of edible shark meat was donated to the Long Island Council of Churches' food pantry to help feed those in need!

RULES & REGULATIONS:

- All boats must sail from and return through Lake Montauk each fishing day.
- Each boat will be issued a tournament number, which must be prominently displayed in the port side cabin window.
- No boat may leave the inlet before 6:00 A.M. and boats must return by 6:00 P.M. on Friday and 5:00 P.M. on Saturday.
- The prize category of the "Other Species" refers only to the minimum size species of **HAMMERHEAD, THRESHER AND TIGER SHARK**. Minimum weight: **MAKO - 125 LBS., BLUE SHARK - 200 LBS., OTHER SPECIES - 150 LBS.** FISH WEIGHED THAT DO NOT MEET THE MINIMUM WEIGHTS MAY COUNT AGAINST A TEAM'S QUALIFYING FISH WEIGHT.
- All I.G.F.A. tackle rules apply. Use of mammal blood or flesh is strictly prohibited. No guns, bang sticks or harpoons.
- Fishing will be held each scheduled day, Captain's choice, no weather committee. Only one day need be fished for the tournament to be considered official.
- All fish must be available for weigh-ins at S.I.Y.C. by 6:00 P.M. on Friday and 5:00 P.M. on Saturday. Weights will be rounded to the nearest pound, with exact 1/2 pounds being rounded up.
- Should there be a tie in any cash prize category, the prize money will be divided equally among the winners.
- In the event of a category not having a winner, that prize money will be divided equally among winning categories.
- In the event of a boat disability, contestants are allowed to transfer to another boat not entered in the tournament, and fish in the name of the original. Fish may not be transferred to another boat.
- Any protests must be presented, at the time of the alleged infraction, to the Tournament Directors. They and the Weighmaster shall serve as judges in such cases and their decision is final.
- In the event of a two-day blow, as per boat safety and judge's decision, prize monies and trophies will be awarded by a drawing.
