21st Annual Mako and **Thresher Tournament:**

Big fish and big money — that is the best way to summarize the two exciting days that took place during the 21st Annual Mako and Thresher Tournament. Two hundred forty anglers aboard 33 boats hit the water to snag the biggest catch and get their share of over \$111,000 in cash, prizes and custom trophies. Fourteen fish were caught, including eleven Makos and three Threshers.

Day 1 saw Capt. James Gravle bring on board his boat "Dream Catcher" a 289-lb. Thresher that would later be named Heaviest Thresher of the day and the tournament and earning the crew almost \$15,000 in cash winnings. Rob Padula on Capt. Frank Rotundo's "Am Sam" caught the Heaviest Mako of the Day and the tournament — a staggering 203 lbs. — and more than \$13,000 in cash prizes and Calcuttas.

During the second day of the tournament, it was Capt. Gary Ramesberger on his boat "Better Days" who had the best day. A Thresher weighing in at 260 lbs. netted Ramesberger and his crew second place for Heaviest Thresher for Day 2, 2nd Heaviest Thresher of the tournament and almost \$22,000 in cash prizes and Calcuttas. Troy Hazen caught a 240-lb. Thresher aboard Capt. Jeff Woerz' "Crack-Oar," giving the crew the 3rd Heaviest Thresher in the tournament.

But it was the crew of "Jack Pot" who lived up to their name, walking away with the most money in the tournament — almost \$50,000 in prize money and Calcuttas. Tony Sansevario snagged a 186-lb. Mako aboard Capt. Rob DiNoto's boat, earning the crew 2nd Heaviest Mako of the tournament honors. In third place was a 167-lb. Mako caught by Juan Baron aboard Capt. Mike Hegarty's "My Rock."

So circle your calendars for July 31st-August 2nd as this two-day competition kicks off with the Captain's meeting on Thursday night, July 31st with tournament fishing on Friday, August 1st and Saturday, August 2nd from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. With prizes expected to exceed \$100,000, this is the late-season tournament that sport fishermen won't want to watch from the dock!

For those anglers who want to get in on the action but don't own a boat, the Star Island Charter Fleet is available for either ONE or BOTH days of the tournament. So round up your crew and get in on the action — July 31st-August 2nd at Star Island Yacht Club in Montauk, the sportfishing capital of the world!



RULES & REGULATIONS:

- 1. All boats must sail from and return through Lake Montauk each fishing day.
- 2. Each boat will be issued a tournament number, which must be prominently displayed in the port side cabin window.
- 3. No boat may leave the inlet before 6:00 A.M. and boats must return by 6:00 P.M. on Friday and 6:00 P.M. on Saturday.
- 4. Minimum weights on all Makos is 100 lbs. Threshers, 150 lbs. Fish weighed that do not meet the minimum weight may count against a team's qualifying fish weight.
- 5. All I.G.F.A. tackle rules apply. Use of mammal blood or flesh is strictly prohibited. No guns, bang sticks or harpoons.
- 6. Fishing will be held each scheduled day, Captain's choice, no weather committee. Only one day needs to be fished for the tournament to be considered official.
- 7. All fish must be available for weigh-ins at S.I.Y.C. by 6:00 P.M. on Friday and 6:00 P.M. on Saturday. Weights will be rounded to the nearest pound, with exact 1/2 lbs. being rounded up.
- 8. In the event of less than 25 boat entries, the prize money will be adjusted accordingly in proportion to the number of entries.
- 9. Should there be a tie in any cash prize category, the prize money will be divided equally among the winners.
- 10. In the event of a boat disability, contestants are allowed to transfer to another boat not entered in the Tournament, and fish in the name of the original. Fish may not be transferred to another boat.
- 11. Any protests must be presented, at the time of the alleged infraction, to the Tournament Directors. They, and the Weighmaster, shall serve as judges in such cases and their decision is final.
- 12. In the event of a two-day blow, as per boat safety and judge's decision, prize monies and trophies will be awarded by a drawing.
